Interested in playing for the Hawks in the upcoming WABL 2025 Season!

The first part of our WABL selection process for 2025 involves selecting teams for the State Championship tournaments in November/December. These trials are in October and registration opens 9th September and will be closed on Fri 4th of October or when number limits are exhausted. Please register early to avoid disappointment

Please read all information for trial selection for WABL 2025 as some adjustments have been made from previous years. All trials will be held at Bendat Basketball Centre unless otherwise notified. If you miss the selection trials in October, the next chance to try out will be October 2025.

Information on Trials

- 2024 trials & State Championship tournaments will be used to select our 2025 WABL Teams.
- “Cuts” can be made after any trial, due to the volume of participants and the need to make decisions early in the process.
- Team announcements will be made via the **Perry Lakes Hawks website and social media channels no emails will be sent**. Following the team announcements, the selected athletes will receive an email asking players to accept their position along with further information and training times for preparation for State Championship tournament.
- 2025 WABL Team allocations will be finalised in 2025. Players may be moved up or down in teams based on performance, attitude, team balance and adherence to Club Values. Cuts may also occur at this time.

The Difference between WABL & Domestic Basketball

WABL (Western Australian Basketball League) is highly competitive with increased expectations on players. WABL players are expected to listen, with a focus on learning to improve their skills and knowledge of basketball. Most players enjoy the challenging environment and thrive on it, it is important to note there is generally higher expectations and more pressure than domestic basketball along with more commitment.

Other important difference include

- NO guarantee of selection – trying out for WABL does not mean the player is guaranteed placement into a team, placement cannot be appealed or disputed.
- Roles- Players can be allocated specific roles in the team based on their size, their abilities, and that of their teammates.
- COURT TIME- With WABL being Basketball WA’s premier junior Basketball competition, players are not rotated evenly as it is often the case in Domestic basketball. Players will have more or less time on court during games depending on a number of factors including skill level, match up to opposition, attitude, behaviour and attendance at training and games.

ABOUT WABL

The WA Basketball League (WABL) is WA's representative junior competition. It is the next level up from Domestic basketball.

WABL is played *for* your basketball association.

Each association can enter up to four teams (10 players per team + plus train on players) in each of the age group, boys and girls

There are 13 basketball associations that field teams in WABL:

Being part of a WA association's WABL program is a **year-round commitment**:

- starting with selection trials in October,
- followed by the State Champs tournaments in November/December,
- then the WABL grading tournament the following February/March, and
- then the WABL season which runs from April to September.

WABL 2025 Commitments

All players and parents/guardians must be prepared to meet the following commitment.

1. Weekly Commitments
 - Sunday Games, home and away (Bunbury to Joondalup and in between)
 - Weekly training sessions 1-2hrs on a scheduled day, attendance is compulsory even if injured.
2. Tournament weekends (all are compulsory unless an exemption is given)
 - State Championship in November / December depending on age group
 - Grading Tournament in February/March
3. Other Sports/activities;
 - Perry Lakes Hawks asks to be notified at registration if a player is playing an alternate sport in 2025 that will impact their availability for training and games. It is important that is disclosed, so we can ensure sufficient players are allocated teams to cover absences. The Club can make changes to team allocation should a player notify us post team selections.
4. Support at Club events.
 - WABL players, and parents, will be required to provide support at events across the season. These will include, but not limited to, NBL1 Game nights, any fundraising and social events.

Financial commitment

The fees involved in 2025 WABL are:

- Trial fee: \$40
- State Champs fee: ~ \$150
- WABL Pre-season Fee: ~\$175
- WABL Season Fee: ~\$550
- Basketball WA Annual Fee (if not already paid via domestic): \$41.75
- Basketball Australia Investment Levy Fee (if not already paid via domestic): \$5
- Weekly WABL Game Fee: \$15 per game
- Hawks WABL Compulsory Uniform items:
 - Playing shorts: \$50
 - Black training shorts: \$35
 - Reversible training singlet: \$35

All WABL teams are required to attend the **WABL grading tournament** for their age group. The tournament dates are:

• Sunday 23 March: U12 Boys, U12 Girls, U16 Boys & U16 Girls

The **WABL season** starts on Sunday 27 April. It runs for 16 weeks + 3 weeks of finals. (There is a two-week break in the July school holidays.) WABL games are played on Sundays and can be anytime from 7.30am to 6pm at venues all over Perth from Joondalup in the north to Bunbury in the south and Mundaring in the east.

Club expectations of players

All selected players are expected to:

- Abide by our [players code](#) of conduct which can be found on our website.
- Attend all scheduled training sessions unless unwell. (Injured players are still expected to attend training.)
- Purchase the compulsory uniform items.

Club expectations of parents

All parents are expected to:

- Abide by our [Parents/spectators code of conduct](#) and our [Zero Tolerance Policy](#)
- Volunteer for scoring duties on their child's State Champs competition weekend and during the WABL season.
